Brother Barry Goldwater was born in Phoenix, Arizona. He served in the U.S. Army Air Force in World War II and as a U.S. Senator from 1953-65 and again from 1969-87. He was candidate for President of the United States in 1964 losing to President Johnson by a landslide. He was a lifelong Freemason, being initiated in Arizona Lodge #2 in Phoenix in 1931, becoming a 33rd Degree Mason in the Scottish Rite and was a Knights Templar in the York Rite.
